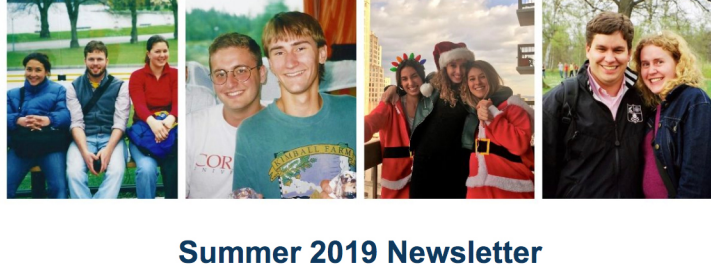

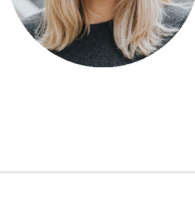

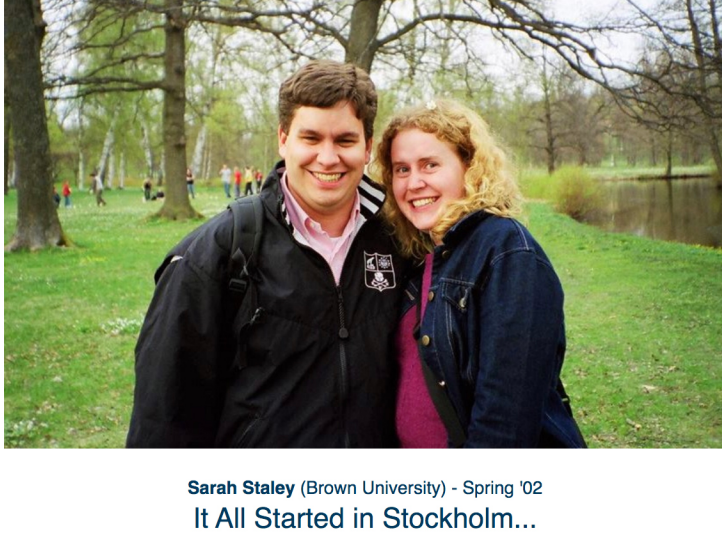


#### Amelia Poole (Colgate University) - Spring '17 An Ongoing International Education - From Stockholm to Boston

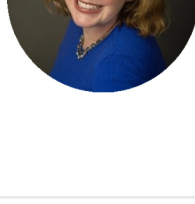
